In II Chronicles 30:10, good king Hezekiah of Judah, sent messengers to the nation of Israel to return unto God. Their response was. "they laughed them to and mocked them." It is much the same in today's world. Secularists scorn and mock Christians who try to live out their faith by following the Bible. The question is why?

Generally, people can be divided into two worldviews: Mankind is good and getting better, or mankind is evil and getting worse. Only one worldview can possibly be right.

The biblical view is that man is created in "the image of God," Genesis 1:27, and has a spiritual component described in Hebrews 4:12 as "soul and spirit." The secular view is that we are nothing more than random elements brought together by chance, environment and time. There is, however, no logical reason why life should spring from randomness, let alone develop emotions such as love or empathy which we exhibit.

What you believe con-

cerning your origin, whether divinely appointed by God, or random evolutionary chance, determines your philosophy of life and how you live it.

For example, the Bible is quite clear as to two genders. Genesis 5:2 declares, "Male and female created he them; ..." This, of course, refers to Adam and Eve, the first recorded family in Scripture. The idea that there are several genders or that homosexuality, transgenderism, bi-genderism or

any other deviation is part of God's plan has no place in the Bible.

Also, the biblical view of the nuclear family, a married father and mother with children, has been stigmatized as flawed and even bigoted. Other structures such as two men or two women are being promoted as just as good or even better.

While it is true that some nuclear families have failed to live up to biblical standards, it does not change the fact that the nuclear family historically is the one best suited for producing a thriving society and content, well adjusted individuals.

Why then do secularists scorn and mock today? The reason seems apparent. Whatever belief system you hold, there is a religious assumption that underlies your philosophy of life. Christianity, with its teachings of the fall of mankind into sin, and its redemp-

tion through repentance and faith in Christ's death on the cross, runs contrary to the self-sufficiency and proud spirit that is common among unbelievers. I Corinthians 3:19 declares, "For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness." I Corinthians 1:18 says, "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God."

Everyone of us makes a choice in life. The Bible declares, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding," Proverbs 9:10. The secularist says doing your own thing and making up the rules as you go, brings happiness, purpose and contentment.
